## Are you searching for housing as a Non Minor Dependent?


Our THP Plus Foster Care housing programs provide housing and services for non-minor dependents ages 18-21.

### Host Housing

- Host Housing serves youth with an adult who can provide them a room in their home as well as a supportive, mentor like relationship.
- Host can be: a former foster parent, caregiver or teacher; relative (excluding biological parents); a coach, pastor or any well-known adult with the capacity and willingness to support the youth as they work to achieve their goals.
- The ideal situation offers the youth the opportunity to build or sustain permanency with their host in safe and stable environments.

### Pregnant and Parenting Community Housing

- Our community house provides safe and secure housing, while residents work and go to school.
- Full time staff available to support all residents.
- All youth receive support through groups, coaching and case management.

## Are you a Transition Aged Youth, under the age of 24 and interested in housing?


Our THP Plus programs provide housing and supportive services. Eligible youth who exited foster care/probation at age 18 in a county that has an approved program plan are highly encouraged to apply.

### Host Housing

- Host Housing serves youth with an adult who can provide them a room in their home as well as a supportive, mentor like relationship.
- Host can be: a former foster parent, caregiver or teacher; relative (excluding biological parents; a coach, pastor or any well-known adult with the capacity and willingness to support the youth as they work to achieve their goals.

### Community Housing

- We have three community houses in the East Oakland areas.
- There are two houses for young women and one for young men, who are out of care youth. One of the houses for women include a home for pregnant and parenting mothers.
- Our community house provides safe and secure housing, while residents work and go to school.
